

May 29th, 2025 NBNA Board Meeting

Board Meeting was called to order at 10 AM.

In attendance: Cheryl Bland, Sue Sharp, Tom Heckenberg, Kimberly Brown

We have 119 members and 6 associate members, in addition, Kim will add herself after donating art supplies for middle school sign project.

The board approved meeting minutes, with Kim to include language needed for the Bank to add Kim and Sue.

We are down roughly \$900 difference in donations this year from last year.

\$11,130 cash, set aside \$4000 for the reserve in savings account, leaves \$7130 available to spend.

Jeremy quit, couldn't build clientele in Nedonna, we have a new person to mow the pond and entry.

Get Art teacher to take pictures of students working on speed signs.

Kim got a timelapse video of students pulling scotchbroom, will add that to Facebook.

Highschool will work on evacuation trails Tuesday June 3rd. We will provide pizza and water. They are interested in future work in Nedonna.

We should send letter to school thanking all of the contacts that coordinated projects, teachers, and students for their work.

We may change donations for roads to go toward north or south roads.. south is always worse.

State park put in the extra porto potty and garbage can at the jetty parking lot.

Ellen contacted the PUD, Cheryl will check with her and make sure we are on the same page with the parking lot light. The purpose of the light was to discourage camping, but it seems to have caused more grief and complaints with the light than without. More complaints than praises, light too bright, encouraging people to hang out and party under the light. Board members all vote to discontinue service.

Cheryl let the county know if they don't want to pay for the light, we will disconnect.

Nedonna Development – DSL is reviewing and there should be an answer this summer on whether that will continue or not. We should check with Mary Johnson. There will be a public hearing June 11th on amending the zoning ordinance. We will email the notices out.

Riley/Beach road still bad. Sent an email to south roads seeking donation. Gravel piles are waning, will need to order more before the annual meeting.

Catherine asked county to maintain the side of Section Line so people can jumo out of the way when cars come.
